The Mount Washington Valley Ski Touring and Snowshoe Foundation has roots in the Valley for over 14 years. A group of interested community leaders established a network of over 60 km of cross country (XC) ski trails linking points of scenic beauty, ski related services and lodging in Intervale, Kearsarge and North Conway. A diverse selection of terrain from easy rolling hills to more challenging intermediate and back country trails is offered. An integrated use and management policy was established with other nonprofit ski foundations, schools, ski teams and clubs and other organizations in the Valley. The Board of Directors includes representatives from the Town of Conway, Conway School District, Eastern Slope Ski Club (a 501 (c) (3) organization) and charitable minded prominent members of the Mount Washington Valley.
